The meeting started at 10.00 a.m. with prayer.

A. Opening Remarks by Hon'ble Chancellor:

- The Chancellor appreciated the contribution of the BoM members, staff and students towards NAAC accreditation with highest score in the Region obtaining NAAC A++ (Grade CGPA of 3.65 out of 4.0).
- The Chancellor stated that the University is graded as Category –I based on the NAAC accreditation score by UGC and thanked the BoM members for their guidance.
- The School of Allied Healthcare Sciences which was approved by BoM members has now officially started teaching Programmes and admission has started. Adequate faculty members have been recruited.

The salient benefits of the University becoming Category – I Institution as stated by the Chancellor:

- 1. No Inspection for University by the UGC.
- 2. Institution can start new programmes, departments, Schools without the support of UGC funds.
- 3. Institution can start new campus within the geographical jurisdiction.
- 4. The Institution can start skill based courses and they can open Incubation Centres.
- 5. The Institution can invite foreign faculty from top 500 Universities based on QS ranking.
- 6. The Institution has the freedom to invite international students (20% more than) the sanctioned strength.
- 7. The Institution can provide incentive structure for foreign faculties from its own sources.
- 8. The Institution can operate collaborative program with foreign institutions.
- 9. The Institution can start Programmes Distance Learning and Online Learning mode.

All the above may be operated without funds from the UGC.

- The Chancellor discussed about, a series of letters from the UGC addressed to the Registrar and the Vice Chancellor stating that no financial assistance will be given for the 77 Teaching and 14 Non-Teaching posts.
- The Chancellor also explained the, New Models for SF rules (i.e., Tenure Track Teaching Staff of Self Financed (SF) Programmes was discussed in Deans Council and Management). Further he stated that, as on 30.06.2022, 236 Faculty members are present in both Campus-I and Campus -II. They are employed for 10

months and relieved from service for a period of 2 months towards the end of the Academic year. Hence, this was discussed in Deans council and Management to bring the new models for Tenure-Track faculty and it is now named as rules for Tenure-Track Teaching Staff of Self-financed (SF) Departments and Teaching Programmes. The Faculty service has been clearly pointed out in rules and the faculty have an advantage of continuous service for 3 years (assessment, monitored after 3 years) without break and are allowed to guide Ph.D scholars and to apply for research projects. Tables 1 & 2 gives salary profile and there is no scale of pay as per UGC regulations. Now, this detailed rules are placed before BoM for approval.

Mr. Abhaya Srisrimal Jain

> Whether the nomenclature of tenure track Teaching faculty, is available in UGC?

Chancellor responded

> Tenure Track Teacher is an accepted terminology of UGC.

Mr. Abhaya Srisrimal Jain appreciated the efforts of Chancellor and authorities and offered the following suggestions.

- Revision of fees structure
- Raising alumni fund support
- Research Centre for Nanotechnology sponsored by Nanolife, which is his Industry.

Chancellor responded

- Because of revision Tenure Track Teaching staff, the additional expenses for the Institute is Rs. 1.3 Crores.
- It is the philosophy of the institute and the founder T. S. Avinashilingam, Ayya to offer affordable quality education for socio-economically, weaker section of women. Hence, alternative sustainable funding model is being created by constituting a taskforce committee.
- Chancellor appreciated Dr. Abhaya Kumar for sponsoring the Research Centre on Nanotechnology.

Remarks of Dr. Sundararaman

Dr. Sundararaman appreciated the SF rules as well-defined and drafted service rules for Tenure Track staff.

- Are you going to give gap after 3 years?
- ➤ Will they be given gratuity after 5 years?
- ➤ Will they have Career Advancement Scheme?

Chancellor responded :

No gap will be given after 3 years but they will be evaluated on their Teaching performance through an expert Committee. If successful, their service will be continued and Career Advancement will be provided as per schedule given in Table 1 and 2.

Gratuity will be given after 5 years as per EPF rules.

All the members unanimously approved the agenda on "Tenure Track Service Rules".

Remarks of Dr. Sundararaman

The fees structure for the SF Programme should be revised.

Chancellor responded :

As suggested by BoM members, fees revision will be taken up on systematic comparative assessment with other institutions. A New fee restructuring Committee will be constituted including external members and their recommendations will be placed in the subsequent BoM.

Dr. G. Lokanadha Reddy and Dr. Thangamuthu appreciated the service rules framed for Tenure Track faculty.

Dr. G. Lokanadha Redddy suggested to conduct online programme, international programme and to start medical college.

Dr. Vijayarani and Dr. Chitramani appreciated Dr. Sundararaman, for suggesting special fees structure for SF courses, which have a high demand.

Chancellor requested the Vice Chancellor to takeover and conduct the proceedings.

<u>4. To consider and approve Addendum of the Agenda Item No. 1 of 123rd Board of</u> <u>Management (sent through circulation dated 13.05.2022)</u>

In view of the Gazette Notification of the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Act, 2021 (No.14 of 2021) dated 28th March, 2021,"The School of Allied Health Science will be known as "School of Allied Healthcare Sciences".

Dr. K. Sundararaman proposed and all BoM members (Online and in person) considered and approved the same.

5. To consider and approve the Change in Nomenclature of Directorate of Research and Development (DORD):

Based on the UGC communication Ref:1-5/2021(NEP/Desk-parl.) dated 08.06.2022 (Annexure – 1), the nomenclature of the Directorate of Research and Development shall henceforth be known as **Research and Development Cell (RDC)** and Dean (R&D) will be **Director (R&D)**.

Dr. Premakumari proposed and all BoM members (Online and in person) considered and approved the same.

6. To consider and approve the revision of fee structure for all the programmes offered in the Institute for the academic year 2022-2023 and onwards.

The Fee Restructuring Committee has suggested revision of the annual fee structure of all the Undergraduate, Postgraduate, PG Diploma and Ph.D. programmes and is presented in Table for approval. The revision in the annual fee structure is justified in terms of the need for allocating budget towards (a) Promotion of Research activities for students and Ph.D. scholars; (b) Seed money for Research for Faculty members (c) Paper presentation in Conference/Seminar/workshops by faculty members, Research scholars and students.(d) Conduct of Seminar/Conference/Workshop/FDP and (e) inviting eminent external experts as Visiting Professor/Faculty/Guest faculty (f) University Research Fellowships for meritorious fulltime Ph.D. candidates and (g) Campus development. The Committee also suggested Fees for the newly introduced programmes in the School of Allied Healthcare Sciences.

The proposed revised fee structure was accepted by all BoM members for the ensuing academic year. The BoM suggested to constitute a new Fee Normalization Committee to define the fees for the forthcoming years.

Dr. K. Sundaraman proposed and Mr. Abhaya Srisrimal Jain approved and uninaminously approved by all BoM members.

7. To consider and approve the results of the Ph.D. Viva Voce conducted since the last BoM meeting

The particulars of candidates, who have attended the Ph.D. Viva Voce examination, through the online mode and the details of the theses defended by them in the viva voce examination are given in **Annexure II** for consideration and approval.

Dr. C. Thangamuthu proposed and Dr. K. Sundararamn approved.

The BoM members approved the same.

<u>8. To consider and approve UGC non-approval for Recruitment of Vacancies under</u> <u>Teaching and Non-Teaching Posts</u>

As per the UGC Circular letter No.D.O.No.F.1-14/2019(CPP-II) dated 26.11.2021, Advertisement was given on 29th December 2021 for 77 Teaching posts and 14 Non-Teaching posts and this was informed to Hon'ble Members of the BoM vide Circulation on 28.12.2021.

The Institute requested UGC vide letter No. AIHS&HE/Estt./E1/2021-22/7682, 29th December 2021 & No. F. AIHS&HE/VC/UGC/2021-22/242, dated 06 May 2022 to grant approval for Screening and Selection and approve the financial assistance to fill up the posts. Now we have received communication from UGC letter No.F.1-2/2020 (DU) dated 30.03.2022 addressed to Registrar (received on 06.06.2022) and Letter No. F.No1-1/2013(DU) Dated June, 2022 addressed to the Vice Chancellor stating that no financial assistance will be given to fill up the posts from UGC. Hence, the BoM is requested to approve the declaration that the applications received in these aspects are considered as null and void (**Annexure –III**).

The Vice Chancellor explained about the call for advertisement for 77 Teaching Posts and 14 Non-Teaching posts as per UGC's directives and further requesting UGC Chairperson and Secretary in person to give permission for Screening & Selection. The Vice Chancellor informed about the receipt of letters from UGC about their inability to support financially and hence requested BoM members to approve the declaration that the applications are considered null and void. Further as per Government of India rules six months are over since advertisement was given.

All the members of the BoM approved for 'Null and Void' decision and stated that applications should not be further processed for Screening.

<u>9. To consider and approve Service Rules and Bye-Laws for Tenure – Track Teaching</u> Staff of Self-financed (SF) Departments and Teaching Programmes – 2022

Service Rules and Bye-Laws for Tenure – Track Teaching Staff of Self-financed (SF) Departments and Teaching Programmes – 2022 is framed and will come into force with effect from the date of approval by the Board of Management of Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women (Deemed University).

These Service Rules and Byelaws are constituted under the following framework.

- b) The Vision and Mission of AVINUTY
- c) Nature of Tenure-Track Appointments
- d) Recruitment and Appointment Policy
- e) Job Description with Duties & Responsibilities
- f) Workload
- g) Termination/Resignation
- h) Disciplinary Byelaws

The Service Rules and Bye-Laws for Tenure – Track Teaching Staff of Self- financed (SF) Departments and Teaching Programmes – 2022 is given in **Annexure-IV**.

All members of the BoM appreciated the authorities for bringing out the Service Rules and Bye-laws for Tenure-Track Teaching Staff.

Dr. Gowri Ramakrishnan : Asked to check whether Rs.2000/- for Tenure Track faculty as incentive as Ph.D is mandatory.

Vice Chancellor: Justified that the faculty on receiving Ph.D will move to the Assistant Professor category.

<u>10. To consider and approve the minutes of the 45th Finance Committee Meeting held on 27.06.2022.</u>

The Forty Fifth (45th) Finance Committee Meeting of Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women was held on 27.06.2022 at 11.00 A.M. at the Board of Management Chamber of the Institute. The detailed agenda and the Minutes of the same are submitted herewith for consideration and approval.

The Minutes of the 45^{th} Finance Committee held on 27.06.2022 is given in **Annexure** – **V** for approval.

Dr. Thangamuthu proposed and Dr. Sundaraman approved.

The BoM members were approved the same.

<u>11. To consider and approve the MACP awarded to Non-Teaching Staff as per UGC</u> <u>regulations</u>

As per i) DOPT Letter No.22034/5/2001-Estt (D), dated August 20, 2001 ii) UGC Letter No. F.41-5/2003(JCRC) dated July 14, 2010. iii) DOPT Government of India Letter No 35034/3/2015-Estt(D) dated 22.10.2019, ACP/MACP Scheme for Central Civilian Government Employees allowed on completion of 10, 20 and 30 years of regular service are counted from the direct entry grade.

Financial upgradation will also be admissible whenever a person has spent 10 years continuously in the same grade pay. (Para 9 of OM dated 19/5/2009)

The Meeting of the Screening/Selection Committee met on 24.06.2022 to award MACP for the following Non-Teaching Staff and recommended MACP as per UGC regulations.
