In connection with the Examination and Evaluation of SWAYAM MOOC Programme, Dr.G.Padamavathy, Professor of Computer Science and the Coordinator of SWAYAM MOOC discussed with Vice Chancellor, Registrar and all the Deans and decided to evaluate the programme in the following manner:

- Minimum period for the completion of the course opted in MOOC will be six months
- The proof of enrolment and course completion need to be submitted to the Controller of Examinations.

- ii) UGC through its letter D.O.No.9-35/2016(CPP-II) dated 15th April,2021,informed that Chartered Accountant/Company Secretary/Cost and Works Accountants Qualification be considered equivalent to PG Degree. (Annexure 37.2)
- iii) UGC through its letter F.No.4-1/2018(NET/Policy) dated January,2021, conveyed its approval for extension of Period for Completion of Master's Degree for June 2018 NET qualified candidates and through letter F.No.4-1/2018 (NET/Policy) dated 30th July,2021 for December 2018 and June 2019 NET qualified candidates. (Annexures 37.3a & 37.3b)

As per the eligibility conditions for National Eligibility Test (NET), the candidates who are pursuing their Master's degree or equivalent course or candidates who have appeared for their qualifying Master's degree (final year) examination and whose result is awaited or

candidates whose qualifying examinations have been delayed can also apply for this test. However, such candidates are admitted provisionally and are considered as eligible for award of JRF/eligibility for Assistant Professor only after they have passed their Master's degree or equivalent examination with requisite percentage of marks within two years from the date of NET result.

Some candidates qualified in the UGC-NET held in July 2018, December 2018 and/or June 2019 or in the Joint CSIR-UGC Test held in June 2018 for Eligibility for Lectureship / Assistant Professor and Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) under the UGC scheme, have not been able to complete their Master's degree or equivalent course due to unavoidable delays in conducting university examinations caused by COVID-19 pandemic.

In the interest of the affected candidates, UGC has taken a decision to extend the last date for completing the Master's degree or equivalent course with requisite percentage of marks as per the eligibility of NET till **31st December 2021 for June 2018 candidates** and **30th June 2022 for December 2018** UGC-NET/Joint CSIR-UGC test and **31st December 2022 for June 2019** UGC-NET/Joint CSIR-UGC Test.

iv) UGC through its letter D.O.No.1-10/2020 (CPP-II) dated 2nd September, 2021, (Public Notice) informed on the Extension of date for submission of thesis for terminal M.Phil./
 Ph.D. thesis till 31st December,2021, which also be applicable to all such students whose due date of submission of M.Phil./Ph.D. thesis is on or before 31.12.2021. However, tenure of fellowship will remain up to five years only. (Annexure 37.4)

38. Other Matters:

Dr.E.Ramganesh, Professor, Head & Chair – School of Education, Bharathidasan University, requested to start Online Diploma courses for employed alumni, to update their knowledge for the job requirement; asked to conduct a survey asking for the alumni's requirement and requested to offer Diploma/Advanced Diplomas on the same, so that the Institution could retain their alumni.

Dr.G.Padmavathi, Dean Academics reported that the Institution is producing number of online resources under various Research Centres which would be made available for the alumni, homemakers & others who would like to pursue Skill based Training and advanced level training from our Institution.

Mr.Visveswaran, Chief Mentor, Hexavarsity asked to guide/take up a research to study how India would be in 2040? ; suggested to establish **Future Study Cell**; asked to provide some Postgraduate programmes through online for the Under Graduates, who are not able to continue their Post Graduates due to financial crisis.

Professor, Dr.E.Ramganesh informed that the achievement of U.S.Universities are due to the retaining of students for atleast 10 years, because the retaining of students for more years in terms of potential would increase the visibility of any Institution and employed alumni should be encouraged to take their higher education in our Institution as the Institution has good governance and high values.

Dr.S.Kowsalya, Registrar of our Institution thanked all the Academic Council members for their active participation and the Chairperson of the Academic Council for the smooth conduct of the Academic Council meeting in a Scientific manner.
