
Career Guidance & Placement Cell

Annual Report - 2019 - 2020

The Placement activities for the year 2019 – 2020 started with an intensive understanding of the students objective in their career or their plans on what Next? after their graduation.

The students focus is as below



In facilitating to the interest of the students, the placement cell functions in training the students towards placement and guide them for higher education. A structured training programme is initiated to all the final year students to be competitive enough to attend campus interviews. The training modules

include soft skill, communication skill, aptitude – logical, verbal reasoning, numerical analysis. Need based technical training and awareness to Central and state service commission exams is organized.

In guiding them to higher education, the interest is identified as to pursue their Master's degree or to pursue in diverse course. The various courses and its entrance exams process in different institutions and its prospects is counseled to the students, for their ready reference.

The environment for students to approach the placement cell is very student friendly and learning resources in the placement cell is made available. Access to internet, mock tests, mock interviews, books for preparing to appear for competitive exams, motivational books are also made available to students for learning. Students are encouraged to register in internshala and coursera for their preferred course of interest. Any new notifications of hiring from Government sectors is brought to the awareness of the students and are encouraged to apply.

Employability assessment test is made to understand the student's strengths and the areas to concentrate for improvising.



Skill training on soft skill, communication and aptitude were provided to the students. 10004 students attended the training sessions.
