Following the recent Ph.D Regulations notified by UGC, as minimum standards, the institution proposes to bring 12 credits to 18 credits for students by undertaking Training workshops on ethics, Biostatistics and Skill learning. Further it is made mandatory that two publications are essential.

- Outcome based Teaching Learning will be followed and assessment is also different and follows a rubric system of direct and indirect methods.
- Follow UG as four years is a requirement.
- For student admission 2023-2024, CUET exams will be conducted before June 2022. So that, students will have choice of Institutions.

• Specific Programs:

- ✓ Internship and Incubation Training.
- ✓ Vocational Training.
- ✓ Face to face teaching along with online Education.
- Two types of development are FDP for teachers (Gurudaksha) and orientation for students, (Deeksharambh).
- Institute has established AIU Avinashilingam Institute Academic and Administrative Development Centre (AADC) by AIU on 09th December, 2022 for continuous capacity building of teaching and administrative staff.
- With regard to governance of revised Deemed to be University UGC Regulations 2022, feedback from stakeholders of our Institute has been sent to the UGC.
