The meeting started at 11.00 a.m. with prayer.

A. OPENING

Opening Remarks by Hon'ble Chancellor

Hon'ble Chancellor expressed that it was a pleasure to address members of BoM and thanked them for their guidance. Hon'ble Chancellor pointed out the achievements of the Institute.

1. Valuable Collaboration which is the Hallmark of our Institute

- a) Collaboration with Indian Institute of Technology(IIT), Madras, with regard to initiation of Rural Research Park at our Institute and introduce online Education. He stated that Respected Managing Trustee, Chancellor and Vice Chancellor met the President, IIT Madras, Research Park, Prof. Ashok Jhunjhunwala and he is interested to mentor our students into the concept of entrepreneurship and incubation.
- b) Collaboration with Sri Sathya Sai University, Puttaparthi and Universities at Sweden and UK to which MoU is to be effected in next month.
- c) Collaboration with Dr. M. S. Swaminathan Research Foundation(MSSRF), Chennai in the presence of its Director Dr. Sowmya Swaminathan and MoU

signed in presence of Chancellor and Vice Chancellor. The Collaborative research is focused on two verticals namely Tribal Foods and Medicinal plants. The Concerned Research faculty were also present.

- d) Strengthening AHS, for all six programs, Collaboration through MoUs with ten different hospitals to train students.
- 2. The Institute is strictly following the rules and regulations of UGC. Based on the grievances of faculty, CAS scheme will be implemented to 63 Teaching staff members and further Screening/Selection Committee will be conducted.
- 3. Filling up of Vacancy positions, key positions vacant are to be filled based on BoM approval.
- 4. For Audit objections existing, it is decided to form a Committee by the Vice Chancellor to bring in effective administrative ecosystem.
- 5. AIU AADC is doing tremendous work and is the Hallmark of our Institute.
- 6. Vision 2040 document prepared in 2021 has to undergo mid-term review. Further, IQAC is entrusted with responsibility of giving details area wise/item wise and instructed that Deans under the leadership of Vice Chancellor will review the document to record success stories. This review report will be intimated to BoM members.

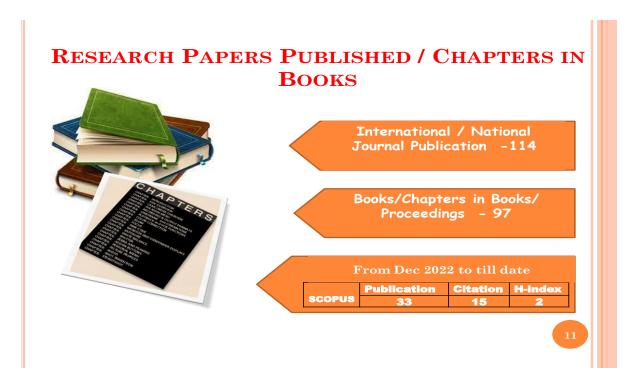

2. To record the leave of absence of the members.

Dr. G. Lokanadha Reddy, Former Vice Chancellor, Dravidan University, Kuppam and **Mr. Abhaya Srisrimal Jain,** Founder and Chairman, Nanolife, Chennai informed their inability to attend the meeting.

3. To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting of the Board of Management.

The minutes of the 126th meeting of the Board of Management held on 15.12.2022 was confirmed.

B. Items for Consideration and Approval

4. To consider and approve the Constitution of Committee for audit related service matters

Constitution of Committee to look into audit related service matters. To authorize the Vice Chancellor to Constitute the said Committee.

1) Objectionable Prof. (CAS) promotion:-

<u>Professor promotion under (CAS) – awarded retrospectively – Not in order – Vide Audit Para</u> <u>No: 44/2017-18</u>

Vide UGC Regulation 2010, Para 6.3.2, it is clarified that "if a candidate who do not fulfil the minimum score requirement under the API scoring system or those who obtain less than 50% in the expert assessment of the selection process will have to be reassessed only after a minimum period of one year."

But the date of promotion shall be the date on which he/she has successfully got reassessed.

And in Para No: 6.3.12 (C), it is also clarified that, "If the candidate does not succeed in the first assessment, but succeeds in the eventual assessment his/her promotion will be deemed to be from the later date of successful assessment."

But in respect of 14 Nos. Teaching staff who were under Audit Remarks were given CAS promotion retrospectively which is not in order. (The details of 14 staff are enclosed herewith – Table-I.

2) Objectionable Selection Grade given (Vide Audit Para No: 24/15-16 & 32/18-19)

On verification, it is found in audit that the following Teaching Staff have also been awarded Selection grade before the completion of mandatory 5 years service from the date of award of Senior Scale and also given a higher pay band of Rs.37400-67000+AGP Rs.9000 from Rs.15600-39100+AGP of Rs.8000, without completing required 5 years of service which is in violation of UGC notification 1998 – Vide lr.No:F3-1/94(PS), dated 24.12.1998 and notification date 4.4.2000. (Copy enclosed) (Table-II).

Though the recovery has been initiated as per the UGC Regulations and clarification, there are grievances submitted by some of the candidates listed in Table II hence it is submitted that a suitable committee may be formed go through the matter and advice the university on the above mentioned service matters.

The members discussed on the Constitution of Committee to look into audit related service matters and authorized the Vice Chancellor to Constitute the said Committee.

Vice Chancellor stated that the CAG and MoE Audit have been completed up to date.

Vice Chancellor stated that there are 900 audit objections existing and by conducting joint sitting, 300 objections have been dropped. Now based on audit objections on Ph.D increments and CAS promotions issued earlier, the concerned staff have requested to Constitute Committee of external experts to look into the issue. So Vice Chancellor be authorized to constitute the Committee. The BoM members authorized Vice Chancellor to constitute the said Committee of Experts.

Dr. Thangamuthu - Committee should have neutral external experts only.

Dr. S. Premakumari stated that already pensioners cases were represented on Junior-Senior pay issues. Will it be considered now if represented?

Vice Chancellor responded that, Pensioners cases will be dealt separately.

Dr. K. Sundararaman - He explained the role of LF and CAG audit reports on Technical issues and Finance.

Dr. K. Sundararaman proposed and all BoM members (Online and in person) considered and approved the same.

5. Starting SF Programme in B.Sc., Biochemistry & Biotechnology in Campus II

Aided programme in B.Sc., Biochemistry and Biotechnology is being conducted by the Department of Biochemistry in Campus I. Considering the demand for the said course, it is proposed to start a similar programme namely B.Sc., Biochemistry and Biotechnology in Campus II as SF Programme.

Dr. G. Padmavathy – When CBCS is approved by the UGC, the new programme BC/BT in SF mode, a double major is not available in UGC list and hence how the state government is going to approve?

Vice Chancellor – We may have to write to UGC and syllabus to be sent to TANSCHE.

The BoM unanimously approved to start SF Programme in B.Sc., Biochemistry & Biotechnology in Campus II.

6. Increase in intake of students in B.E., Artificial Intelligence & Data Science, School of Engineering

B.E., Artificial Intelligence and Data Science was introduced in the year 2020 under School of Engineering in Campus II. Considering the demand for the said course, it is proposed to increase the sanctioned intake of students from 30 to 60. This has been given in the application submitted to AICTE Portal.

Dr. C. Thangamuthu proposed and Dr. K. Sundararamn approved.

The BoM members approved the same.

(i) Maintenance Cell – with the existing human resources and the Computer Centre.

Internal Member

Under this vertical, all maintenance including maintenance of website will be carried over.

(ii) Design and Development Cell – with a new team comprising of Systems Administrator, Senior Programmer and Programmer. Systems Administrator should be someone who has got commendable experience with ERP and also familiar with the eCampus of the Institute.

Under this team, the designing and development of software including maintenance of eCampus, upgrading the existing software with various modules like Leave management module, Hostel information module, Asset management module etc. will be carried out.

As per the recommendations of the Committee, the responsibilities and activities of the Design and Development Cell has been framed as following:

- ➤ The Cell shall be responsible for computerization of the required software / information systems of the Institution.
- ➤ The Cell shall be responsible for designing, implementing and maintaining software systems for various Departments / Sections.
- ➤ The Cell shall give necessary technical assistance in computerization in the Institution.
- ➤ The Cell shall be responsible for providing training for the concerned Officers in charge of processing payroll, provident fund, income tax etc. computerized systems.
- ➤ The Cell shall be responsible for providing training for data entry work required for various computerized systems implemented.

Regarding Learning Management system required for carrying out Open Distance and online Learning programmes of the Institute, the committee recommended to go in a phased manner and to implement in a year with a basic level of infrastructure.
