cancer, sepsis, obesity and insulin resistance in type II Diabetes mellitus with various parameters. She also clearly clarified the doubts and the queries raised by the faculty and research scholar. 

Special Lecture by Alumni in the National Symposium on “Career Prospects in Biosciences”

21st January 2020

The Department of Biochemistry, Biotechnology and Bioinformatics, School of Bioscience organized a one-day National Symposium on “Career Prospects in Biosciences” on 21st January 2020 under DST CURIE phase II activities for the year 2019-2020. The symposium was sponsored by the Department of Science and Technology (DST).

The first session was taken over by our alumna Dr. M. Vasanthi, who spoke on the topic “Recent Advancement and Research in Biosciences”. She started with the different colours of biotechnology corresponding to different biotechnical fields which should be worked upon. She explained the paradigm shift towards systems biology and how the protocol for the same experiment varies widely while working with different type of cells. She touched upon several points regarding advancement in research which actually means advancement in concepts in parallel with the advancement in tools. She also spotted out different omics techniques which has blossomed recently and thus intimated the need for bioscience students to know computer programming, physics and chemistry in order to progress in this field. Thus she concluded by quoting that the students today must have a mindset to learn, unlearn and relearn.

The Two-Day HDC WORKSHOP

conducted by Ms. Sadhana

Alumnae, Department of Computer Science

On 16th & 17th September, 2019 a two days workshop was organized for all the PG students of Department of Computer Science on the topic of “**Holistic Personality Development By HDC**” conducted by **Mrs. Sadhana**, Coimbatore.

The session was started with the small introduction about the cause of holistic personality development and how it is more important for everyone to analyze their own individual skills, quality, ability and traits towards their life skills & career goals. They explained about the following values related to human life skills are as follows,

Humans are, bio magnetic entities emitting frequencies and vibrate according to the thought waves. It involves the following intelligence perspectives,

- Body – Physical Quotient(PQ)
- Mind – Intelligent Quotient(IQ)
- Heart – Emotional Quotient(EQ)
- Soul/Spirit – Spiritual Quotient(SQ)

Left Brain—language, math, writing, science, facts, logic, convergence, critical thinking.

Right Brain – Intuition, artistic, musical, insightful, imagination, 3D images, divergence, creative thinking.

Then they distribute the forms to all which contains certain type of self analysis questions which is to be filled by all the students of their own unique interest and thinking. Some of the questions like interest, short term goal, long term goal, hobbies, social works, the person who is more important in your life, order your top 10 goals according to your aspects, job position, salary expectations, Date of birth, Birth time with signs, most memorable incident in your life, etc...

After that they split the students into teams and they given a group activity for each member in a group to evaluate the individual & team performance according to their skills set. Each team has given a team name, team leader, team assistant leader, team color, and their associate team members were allocated. Each team activity topics includes,

- Emerging trends – For Eg., 3D printing, cloud computing...
- Tech startup – For Eg., Prop tech
- Country IT Policy – For Eg., Australia
- IT Company Case Study – For Eg., IBM (SWOT Analysis)

For each topic the team members want to prepare the PPT's for presentation, and chart work related to each of the given topic. Finally the team should present their presentations and their chart work explanation in a brief, each member in a team want to present their own ability and skills towards them to analyze each individual quality and the team coordination for team evaluation has to be done to improve to improve the personality development of each and every students.

They also point out some of the pros and cons of each and everyone's skills during their presentations which will be help them to improve their career and personality development for future trends and to survive in a current technological era.

They give lots of ideas for students those who prefer for government jobs, private jobs, teaching jobs, self employment and how to improve the entrepreneurship development for their future career goals.






Fig 1: Explanation about “Governance”



Haripriya, Associate Professor (Alumni), Department of Food Science and Technology, Pondicherry University, Puducherry on 23th August 2019. The lecture was focused on the analysis of physiochemical characteristics of foods including volume, thickness, bulk density, water absorption capacity, syneresis, oil absorption capacity, crystalline pattern, gelation and pasting characteristics of starch flours including peak viscosity and retrogradation point and color parameters. Food morphological characterization using Scanning Electron Microscope was also focussed.



International guest lecture on Measurement of Aflatoxin – Experiences in the fields’

The Department of Food Science and Nutrition and Nutrition Association, Nutrition Society of India (Coimbatore Chapter) organized an international guest lecture on Measurement of Aflatoxin – Experiences in the fields’ of Malawi & Tanzania by Dr. S. Anitha, Senior

Scientist of International Crops Research Institute for the Semi – Arid Tropics (ICRISAT), Malawi as well as meritorious Alumnae of the institute on 24th January 2020.

The presidential Address was given by Dr. S. Kowsalya, Registrar as well as Convenor of the Nutrition Society of India, Coimbatore Chapter. She emphasized on the quite possible presence of aflatoxin in millets, toxicity of aflatoxin in stunting the growth of children and requirement of high temperature in the elimination of aflatoxin which is quite stable and not removable while washing. The key speaker Dr. S. Anitha, emphasized on the highest prevalence of aflatoxin contamination in crops like maize and groundnuts relating to the malnutrition in Africa. In Africa, 33 to 34 per cent of the prevalence of malnutrition is attributed to the exposure to aflatoxin, which is a toxin that inhibits the absorption of nutrients. Aflatoxin binds with albumin protein and throughout the three month cycle of physiological process, it damages the liver resulting in liver cirrhosis and liver cancer and causes more liver diseases due to the exposure to aflatoxin even among those who have not alcoholism and hepatitis infection. Aflatoxin can be microbiologically diagnosed for its presence through the observation of blue colouring indicating the AflatoxinA type. In Malawi, different districts were found for the presence of more than 2000 ppb of aflatoxin in the years between 2007 and 2009, which is higher than the acceptable consumption level of 20ppb. India is found with the consumption of 30ppb of aflatoxin. The different types of aflatoxin and their alarming health ill effects attracts the serious medical attention. Very recently, Nagaland was reported for the contamination of milk with aflatoxin M1 and quite a heavy number of deaths of people also. In Malawi, women are more affected to the consumption of aflatoxin due to the reasons that women preferably consume groundnuts while harvesting. The vulnerable conditions for the contamination of groundnuts with aflatoxin includes poor storage facility like mud houses and drying of groundnut not to the adequate level of less than 10 per cent of moisture in groundnuts and the breaking technique is that soaking in water and then breaking kernels invites contamination.

In Malawi, the training for farmers for the production of groundnuts free of aflatoxin is given focusing on counteracting the causes for the contamination with aflatoxin. The training includes no damages while harvesting, not throwing contaminated seeds in to healthily harvested seeds, not adding water after drying with the attitude of increasing the weight of kernel in a profitable way, shelling and sorting techniques which can reduce 30 -40 percent of the spread of *Aspergillus*, the microbe producing aflatoxin, storage in wooden pallet, marketing based on the grading for the level of presence of aflatoxin. .

Hence the guest lecture was quite an impetus to take up aflatoxin eradication based projects among students, which can be a suitable mean for getting placed in UNICEF, WHO and FAO like higher organization and research institution.


projects based on creating application and self-developing individual like entrepreneurs were discussed.
