## 38. Introduction of B.Voc programmes from 2014-2015 & onwards as per UGC's letter No. F. 6-1/2013(DU) dated 30.9.2013

a. Introduction of New Vocational Programmes

b. Converting few existing Programmes into B.Voc. Programmes.

c. Introducing Vocational components into few other existing programmes

The Vice Chancellor explained about the UGC's letter regarding the B.Voc. programmes which are very much required by the industries now. She also stressed that even the highly qualified students are not having the skills required by the industries, hence Skill Knowledge Providers may be utilized for inculcating the necessary skills required by the job providers, among the student community.

The Academic Council approved the introduction of vocational programmes in principle.

## 39. Equivalent course for a repeater

K. Baby (08UCA07) rejoined the Undergraduate Programme in Computer Applications - BCA - in the sixth semester. She has to complete Soft Skill II in the sixth semester. This is not offered to any of the batches in the even semester.

Approval from the Academic Council members is requested to permit her to

1) follow the syllabus of 2010-2011 batch to write the examination soft skill.

2) Write one CIA test for 25 marks and the final Semester Examination for 25 marks.

The Academic Council permitted the candidate to attend the Soft Skill classes along with II year (4th Semester) students.

40. D-Space, the open source software as an institutional repository for uploading earlier semester question papers in the University Library

DSpace is an open source software used as an institutional repository. It can be used for question papers, journal articles, datasets, electronic theses, reports, conference rs and images. We inform the Academic Council members that initiative is taken to implement the software in the University Library through internet.

The Academic Council accepted the same.

# 41. Suggestions requested from Academic Council regarding Equivalence Certificate.

The Chairperson of the Academic Council reported that some of our University's passed out students have asked for Equivalence Certificates for their subjects either for doing higher studies or for their Job. She also expressed that the students of our University are not considered for job opportunities, in case of the subjects like Life Sciences and Applied Chemistry.

Dr. P.V.L. Rao expressed that almost all the Universities are facing this problem of equivalence certificate.

The Vice Chancellor Dr. (Mrs.) Sheela Ramachandran explained that the State Government Appointment Authority is not accepting readily the new nomenclature of the subjects and hence asked the Chairpersons of the Boards of Studies of various Boards to bring the novelty within the syllabus and not with nomenclature of the subjects.

The Registrar, Dr. (Mrs.) Gowri Ramakrishnan reported that during this academic year, about 46 passed out students had asked for Equivalence Certificate for various subjects either for doing Higher Studies or for employment purposes and explained the problems faced by the University, by the State Governments which are not considering some of the subjects offered by our University.

The Vice Chancellor, Dr. (Mrs.) Sheela Ramachandran asked the Chairpersons of the Boards of Studies of various Boards to prepare report justifying about the equivalence of the courses offered by their Department and ratified in the next Academic Council and thereby Board of Management.

The Academic Council accepted the Chairperson's suggestion.

## 42. Other Aspects:

Dr. P. Santhanakrishnan, Director (Research & Consultancy) asked the basis for framing the specialization paper of M.Phil. programme. The Academic Council recommended to work on Common Guidelines for framing the paper in the Research Advisory Committee meeting.

Dr. N. Jaya appreciated the efforts taken by the Biochemistry Department for preparing the Additional list of Journals.

The Vice Chancellor appreciated all the departments for their efforts.

The meeting came to end by proposing vote of thanks to the Chairperson of the Academic Council.
