Teaching

Co-curricular / Certificate Courses in Gender and Empowerment for II UG students of different departments and for II B.P.Ed and II B.Ed. students, Gender and Education is offered by the Women's Studies Centre. A total of 159 students from different disciplines were enrolled during the period 2017-18.





Training / Workshop

Social and Legal Awareness for Women, Girls and Senior Citizens:

Women's Studies Centre organized a "Social and Legal Awareness Programme in collaboration with the Department of Social Welfare, Coimbatore on 21st February, 2017. Women, Police personnel, women lawyers, retired government officers and women academicians participated and discussed about the safeguard measures to be taken for adolescents, orphanages and senior citizens. Sixty girls from orphanages and senior citizens from the Retirement home of Social Welfare Department participated and benefitted.

Capacity Building for Young Women: Ways and Means of Approaching Competitive Examinations

One day Workshop on "Capacity Building for Young Women: Ways and means of approaching competitive Examinations" was conducted in collaboration with the University SC/ST

Dr. B. Tamilmani, Professor of Co-operation, Co-ordinator, Coaching scheme for Entry in Services (CENTSERV), Gandhigram Rural Institute (Deemed to be University), Dindigul was the key resource person. They were oriented on effective ways of empowering themselves, how to prepare and write competitive examinations. They were provided information on various competitive examinations in the country. The workshop also covered effective ways of appearing for interviews. Totally 70 students from final year belonging to SC/ST were benefitted.

Workshop on Empowerment of Young Women Through Skill Development 13th to 15th March 2017

This Programme was conducted in collaboration with the University SC/ST Cell. With the view to provide certain skills in order to empower SC/ST students of the University. The programme was inaugurated by Mr. S. Saravanan, IPS Deputy commissioner of Police-Traffic, Coimbatore. He gave a very inspiring talk based on his own background of first generation graduates where he had to figure out his own future. He was able to relate the SC/ST students based on his experiences as a student. Twenty Five Undergraduate students from Economics, English and Tamil were benefitted.

On day 1 of the workshop, they were provided basic computer skills such as MS Word, MS Excel, MS Power Point etc.

On the 2nd day they were oriented to develop Self confidence, Communication skills and Business Skills.

On the 3rd day they were given exposure to food product development including food packaging and labeling. **Dr. Saraswathy Eswaran,** Secretary, Ramaswamy Chinnammal Trust, Vadavalli, trained the students to prepare various recipes using millets.

Thiru. Lakshmi Kanthan, Chairman Sivoha Human Development Organisation, Coimbatore was the Chief Guest of this workshop.

International Women's Day 2017

Women's Studies Centre celebrated the International Women's Day on 8th March 2017. As part of the programme the Institute honoured the women achievers, who were selected from different fields. They were environmentalists, athletes, social workers and differently abled







woman. The women achievers of 2017 were Ms. M.A. Aparna, Swachh Bharat Ambassador and Social Activist, Mrs. Shanthi Sundar who is visually challenged and inspiring personality, Ms. M. Sudha, athlete who is known as 'Malairani' and Mrs. G.P. Godanavalli, a social worker and family counsellor.

The Centre has also introduced a new course M.A. in Women's Studies and Entrepreneurship.

The Centre organized a competition and it motivated the young students to become social entrepreneurs.

The best two proposals were selected and cash prize was awarded. The winners were the team of students from PSG College of Arts and Science (cash prize of ₹ 5,000) and students from Engineering Faculty of Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women (Cash prize of ₹ 3000). The selected students were mentored by the Women's Studies Centre personnel.

On the same day Women's Studies Centre organized a free eye check up camp in collaboration with Sankara Eye Hospital with the aim to create specific awareness on preventive eye care.







Roundtable Discussion on Social Enterprise and Women Empowerment

On 9th March 2017, the Women's Studies Centre in collaboration with the British Council and IIT Madras organized a round table discussion on "Social Enterprise and Women Empowerment" to understand the linkages between social enterprise activity and the empowerment of women through socio-economic development. Thirty three participants including Social Entrepreneurs, Industrialists, Business Organizations, Government Representatives, Media persons, NGOs, Companies with Corporate Social Responsibilities and



from Financial Institutions, attended and participated in the discussion in the roundtable conference.

Gender Sensitization Programme for Adolescent Boys and Girls

A Two day programme on "Gender Sensitization" was organized for adolescent boys and girls of the Railway Mixed High School, Podanur from 6.12.2017 to 7.12.2017. Fifty five students both boys and girls were benefitted out of this programme. The topics covered were

The inaugural address was given by **Dr. Asha R. Rao**, MD of Rao Hospital, Coimbatore. She also handled the first session and deliver a lecture on "Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome [PCOS]". **Dr. Savitha**, Rao Hospital handled the next session and talked on "Menstrual Hygiene and Reproductive Health".



An interactive session was organised at 1.30 p.m. followed by a Medical Camp. BMI, Blood Pressure, Hemoglobin, Blood Glucose Levels were assessed. About 800 members were benefitted by this campaign.

ATMA Farm women from 8 blocks in Coimbatore and Tirupur districts were trained on value added millet products. Ten SHG women are working as wage earners in the trust. Their products are sold in mobile mart which was sponsored by NABARD.
