





**Vice Chancellor**: We have already 4 year BE Programmes and 4 year B.Voc Programmes. We need to have Rationale and preliminary syllabus for CBCS system for 4 year programmes. Now, we are adapting LOCF pattern for all three year UG Programmes.

**Mr. Ravichandran:** Do all books come under copyright? **Vice Chancellor:** All Books and Journals are publications.

**Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam**: Is there any policy for publications?

Vice Chancellor: All publications should be in UGC CARE/SCOPUS/WoS. The UGC

Regulations are minimum standards and as per our Institute Policy, two journal publications are a must for research scholar.

**Dr. Mangalasundar Krishnan:** Create an archive of journals and let the first date of publication be listed in Archive.

**Vice Chancellor** replied that, Total No. of Credits is 122.

- **Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam**: Announce as 4 year Honors Degree. After 3 years and BoS & Academic Council is to pass 4<sup>th</sup> year as online and the entire 4<sup>th</sup> year (2 semesters) as stipendiary. The benefit for the student is apprenticeship. 4<sup>th</sup> Year fees may be paid by the student from her stipend.
- Dr. N. Vasugi proposed and Mrs. S. S. Manimozhi seconded the motion.

All the members of the Executive Council unanimously approved the minutes of the 44<sup>th</sup> Academic Council.

## <u>Item No. $05(130^{th}\ EC/2023/05)$ – Permission sought by The Avinashilingam Education</u> Trust to use the land

Permission sought by The Avinashilingam Education Trust to use the land sponsored in the name of "Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women" into an affiliated college to strengthen and expand the existing SF Programmes (Annexure - 02).

Taking into consideration the fact that the Institute will be incurring huge expenditure for developing infrastructure and other facilities and also the fact that the Trust has paid the consideration for the land, the Avinashilingam Education Trust may proceed on the basis that this consent will not be revoked.

It was also pointed out that as per the National Education Policy(NEP), there can be stand alone institutions under the cluster concept run by the same Trust as part of an integrated educational set up.

Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan proposed and Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam seconded the motion.

All the members of the Executive Council unanimously approved this permission.

## $\underline{\textit{Item No. 06}(130^{\textit{th}}\,EC/2023/\,06)} - \text{ Centre for Online Learning}(COL) \text{ to offer UG, PG,} \\ \text{Diploma and Certificate Programmes}$

As per UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION (Extraordinary) No. F.1-1/2020 (DEB-1) dated  $4^{th}$  September, 2020, the institution is proposing to offer online degree programmes for which a specific 'Centre for Online Learning' will be established. The details with timelines for the plan of action are given in the **Annexure** – **03**.

As part of its expansion plans, the Institute proposes to start a Centre for Online Learning to offer UG, PG, Diploma and Certificate programmes.

The members of the Executive Council are requested to approve the above initiative and to suggest appropriate further course of action to augment the expansion plans of the Institute.

**Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan** : Is UGC permission required for all online programmes?

**Vice Chancellor**: The regulation is that any programme that has been offered for a batch (3 years) in the face to face mode can be offered in the online mode.

**Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam**: UGC allows 40% of courses online; Ask faculty to develop courses and be involved in e content creation. Let the experts discuss the

Instructional Design, Web design and the contents are ready for online. UGC approval is not required for certificate and Diploma Progammes.

- **Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan:** Teaching-Learning model may be shared.
- **Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam:** Advised that the nomenclature for B.Com may be general and as per UGC norms, the degree may be offered with minor specializations viz., Accounting and Finance etc.,
- **Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan:** Nearly 40% of the courses may be adopted from Swayam Board.

Certificate courses may also be offered. Template is available in the Consortium for SWAYAM Courses.

**Mr. Ravichandran**: Can a 1<sup>st</sup> year student earn credits from other universities?

**Vice Chancellor:** The concept of ABC (Academic Bank of Credits) is adopted in NEP and it is possible to transfer credits.

- **Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam**: As an University, the Academic Council has to approve.
  - Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam proposed and Dr. A. Pankajam seconded the motion.

All the members of the Executive Council unanimously approved.

### <u>Item No. 07(130<sup>th</sup> EC/2023/07) – Proposal on the model of "night college"</u>

Considering the requests of women working students to continue their education and for upskilling their knowledge, it is proposed to start programmes on the model of "night college" with working hours in the evenings and on holidays. To begin with, the existing infrastructure will be utilized to offer UG/PG programmes.

**Vice Chancellor:** To enhance the revenue and the demand for certain courses, the Model followed in 'PUNE' may be adopted as 'NIGHT COLLEGE'.

#### **Shri. G. Ravichandran**: How is it different from evening college?

**Vice Chancellor:** After Regular hours, from 2-8 pm and during holidays, classes will be conducted.

- **Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan:** If there are enough applicants, fee structure may be raised nominally.
- **Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam:** As Eye health problems are more in India, along with B.Optometry, Masters in Optometry may be started; as online program/evening college and

working people may adopt. With industry partners, it may be a CSR initiative also. Give credits for their day to day work also.

**Vice Chancellor:** Only top three programmes in demand like B.Sc., FSN; B.Sc., Special Education program & B.Com general will be introduced in the beginning in addition to PG Diploma.

**Mrs. Suguna Lakshminarayanasamy:** Is it for UG progrmme? If so, it is a good initiative. Is it for an extended period?

**Vice Chancellor:** The period of study is not extended.

**Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan:** If the student needs an year of extension, it may be allowed.

**Dr. K. Manimozhi, CoE:** Based on our earlier experience of Tanzania programme, extension period of time should be carefully followed.

**Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan:** After a stipulated period of time, the registration may be cancelled.

**Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam:** Suggested the name of the programme **as Continuing Education Programme(CEP)** instead of 'Night College' or Evening College.

Shri. Ravichandran proposed and Dr. A. Vijayalakshmi seconded the motion.

The Executive Council unanimously approved the proposal to start Continuing Education Programme on the model of "night college".

### <u>Item No. 08(130<sup>th</sup> EC/2023/08) – Centre for Communication Skills</u>

Communication skills play a major role in the placement and career progression of students. - 2. Communication & Soft Skills courses for Final year UG students of Arts & Science, Engineering and B.Ed & B.P.Ed students.
- 3. The following Certificate courses will be offered to UG & PG students for Self Enhancement:
  - Mastering English Communication (Level − 1)
  - Mastering English Communication (Level − 2)
- 4. The following certificate courses will be offered to the Non Teaching Faculty for Self Enhancement:
  - Effective Workplace Communication
  - Administrative Capacity Enhancement

**Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan:** Part time faculty may be engaged to conduct aptitude training.

#### **Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam:** Do you get feed back?

**Vice Chancellor:** Last 1 ½ years feedback was obtained and based on that 75:25 of Internal trainers: Professional trainers (5 years expansion) are proposed.
