





Observations:

The members appreciated the elaborate report presented by the Vice Chancellor. In response to the different queries raised, the following points were presented.

- a) The Local Chapter of ICMAI at the Avinashilingam Institute will have external experts handling classes. Some of the existing faculty members will also handle based on their specialization. It was advised to integrate topics from CA and ICWA in the Commerce curriculum in the ensuing Board of Studies meeting.
- b) The emphasis on Indian Knowledge System in the curriculum is part of the adoption of the National Education Policy (NEP) and also provides scientific validation.
- c) The four year Honours Degree has been adopted but not yet implemented. Members concurred that it will help students who want to go abroad for Higher Education.

2. To record the leave of absence of the members

Dr. (Mrs.) A. Vijayalakshmi and Mrs. Suguna Lakshminarayanasamy were on leave of absence and other members were present. Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan attended online.

<u>Item No.03(131st EC/2023/03)</u> - <u>To review the actions taken based on the 130th Executive</u> Council Meeting held on 16.08.2023

The action taken based on the 130^{th} Executive Council meeting held on 16.08.2023 (Item Nos.04 to 11 were approved / permitted, Item Nos.12 to 29 were informed and Item Nos.30 to 42 were ratified), approved by the Executive Council.

Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam proposed and Dr. N. Vasugi seconded the motion.

B. Items for Consideration and approval

<u>Item No.04(131st EC/2023/04)</u> - <u>To consider and approve the results of the Ph.D. Viva Voce conducted since the last Executive Council meeting conducted on 16.08.2023</u>

The particulars of candidates, who have attended the Ph.D. Viva Voce examination, and the details of the theses defended by them in the viva voce examination are given in **Annexure - 01** for consideration and approval.

To the query on changes made in the recent Ph.D regulations by the UGC, it was pointed out that, they provide the minimum standards. Hence, the Institute has retained two publications in SCOPUS/WoS/UGC CARE as requirement for completing the Ph.D programme.

Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam proposed and Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan seconded the motion.

The Executive Council unanimously approved the same.

<u>Item No.05(131stEC/2023/05)</u> - <u>Withdrawal of VRS - Dr. S.N. Geethalakshmi, Professor(CAS)</u> of Computer Science

Dr. S.N. Geethalakshmi, Professor(CAS), Department of Computer Science has submitted letter for VRS on 16.08.2023 to retire from 14.11.2023 f.n. (3 months notice) to meet out family commitments. Subsequently she has submitted another letter on 21.08.2023 stating that, she has changed the VRS date as 02.09.2023 to relieve on 30.11.2023.

On 02.09.2023, she has submitted a letter stating that, she will withdraw her VRS letter dated 16.08.2023, but there is no mention about the letter submitted by her on 21.08.2023 (Annexure -02).

All members unanimously permitted the faculty, Dr. S. N. Geethalakshmi, to withdraw her request for VRS with a condition that if she again submits VRS, it will be considered as final VRS statement for relieving the staff. Further, the Council suggested that a letter of undertaking is to be obtained from Dr. S. N. Geethalakshmi as this should not be cited as precedence by other faculty in the University.

Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan proposed and Dr. G. Padmavathi seconded the motion.

The Executive Council unanimously approved the same.

<u>Item No.06(131stEC/2023/06)</u> – <u>Dr. (Mrs.) V. Bharathi Harishankar, Vice Chancellor's visit to U.S.</u>

Dr. V. Bharathi Harishankar, Vice Chancellor has been nominated for the International Visitors Leadership Programme (IVLP) by the U.S. Department of State. The same has been reported in the 130th Executive Council. The request for on Official Duty during December 2023 is placed for approval.

The Vice Chancellor explained about her nomination for the International Visitors Leadership Programme (IVLP) by the U.S. Department of State. The programme will focus on "Excellence in Higher Education in the QUAD" and the team includes members from India, Australia and Japan. All members of Executive Council congratulated Vice Chancellor for this honour and wished her Best of Success. All members insisted that, 'ON OFFICIAL DUTY' should be given to the Vice Chancellor.

When, Dr. V. Bharathi Harishankar, Vice Chancellor avails on Official Duty for a month in December 2023 during her visit to the US, it is placed for discussion that a senior Dean is placed as in charge to carry out the routine activities.

Some members averred that given the technological advances, decisions can be taken by the Vice Chancellor wherever she travels. It was resolved that the senior Dean placed as in charge

should work along with the Finance Officer to look into day to day matters only and the same has to be reported to the Vice Chancellor and Chancellor immediately to get their approval.

<u>Item No.07(131stEC/2023/07) – Advertisement dated 12.04.2023 for discussion</u>

An advertisement calling for applications for the posts of Registrar, Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations and Assistant Controller of Examinations was released on 12.04.2023 and the last date of submission was 11.05.2023. Due to unforeseen delays, the process of recruitment could not be completed within the stipulated period of six months.

Hence, permission was sought and granted to advertise the posts again. Since these are statutory posts, they cannot lie vacant and there is no separate permission to be sought. Further, there has to be a time bound mechanism for an individual holding the statutory post as in charge.

It was unanimously resolved to authorize the Vice Chancellor to advertise the posts and complete the process at the earliest.

Dr. S. Vaidhyasubramaniam proposed and Dr. Mangalasunder Krishnan seconded the motion.

<u>Item No.08(131stEC/2023/08)</u> - <u>Completion of tenure and lien period as Registrar by Dr. S. Kowsalya</u>

Dr. S. Kowsalya was appointed as Registrar (tenurrial post) on lien from Department of Food Science and Nutrition on 09.11.2016 for a period of five years. After the completion of tenure, she has been directed to continue on lien until further orders vide communication dated 08.11.2021.

The matter was discussed in detail. The Executive Council opined that she has reached the maximum permissible on lien period. The Executive Council unanimously resolved the following:

- a) To advertise for the post of the Registrar and complete the selection process in a timely manner
- b) To authorize the Vice Chancellor either to continue the services of the present incumbent or nominate any other qualified faculty as Registrar in charge till the selection process is completed

<u>Item No.09(131stEC/2023/09)</u> - <u>Completion of seven year period as Controller of Examination</u> (i/c) by Dr. K. <u>Manimozhi</u>

Dr. K. Manimozhi was appointed temporarily as full time in charge as Controller of Examination with effect from 07.09.2016, from her parent department – Resource Management. In partial modification of this order she was placed as Controller of Examinations i/c for a period of six months from 07.09.2016 and extendable for further period (vide office communication No.AIHS&HE/2016-2017/173 dated 24.10.2016) by a selection committee comprising Vice Chancellor, Registrar and internal experts. It was further extended on 07.03.2017.

Dr. K. Manimozhi has completed seven years in the present post.

The matter was discussed in detail and the Executive Council unanimously resolved the following:

- a) To advertise for the post of the Controller of Examinations and complete the selection process in a timely manner
- b) To authorize the Vice Chancellor either to continue the services of the present incumbent or nominate any other qualified faculty as Controller of Examinations in charge till the selection process is completed

The department of Computer Science and Engineering in School of Engineering has applied first time to National Board of Accreditation (NBA) for Accreditation of its B.E undergraduate program. The department has submitted Pre-qualifier, which is a prerequisite before submission of application, to NBA on 3rd May 2021 by paying Rs.23,600/- (10% of the total fee for one program). The NBA has approved the Pre-qualifier report submitted by the department and informed the department to submit the application in the form of Self Assessment Report (SAR) applicable for Tier-I institutions.

The department has prepared the Self Assessment Report (SAR) incorporating all the relevant data for three academic years 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 and submitted SAR through e-portal initially on 09-09-2021 by paying the balance amount of Rs.2,12,400/-. After receiving information from NBA to include the data of the academic year 2021-22 also, the SAR was again submitted on 18-11-2022. Again as the expert team visit was delayed by NBA, once again 2022-23 data was also included in SAR and submitted on 25-09-2023.

The Self Assessment Report consists of two parts namely Part-A and Part-B. Part-A relates to Institutional Information and Part-B relates to the Program level information. In part-B, there are 10 Criterions (7 criterions 1 to 7, related to CSE department and 3 criterions related to first year and Institutional information) carrying 1000 marks. The 10 criterions with the marks for each criterion are given below:

Program level Criteria

- 1. Vision, Mission and Program Educational Objectives (50)
- 2. Program Curriculum and Teaching Learning Processes (100)
- 3. Course Outcomes and Program Outcomes (175)
- 4. Students' Performance (100)
- 5. Faculty Information and Contributions (200)
- 6. Facilities and Technical Support (80)
- 7. Continuous Improvement (75)

Institute Level Criteria

- 8. First Year Academics (50)
- 9. Student Support Systems (50)
- 10. Governance, Institutional Support and Financial Resources (120)

Out of 1000 marks/points, if a program scores more than 750 marks accreditation will be given for 6 years and the program attains between 600 and 750, accreditation will be given for 3 years.

The Peer team (3 members) from NBA has visited School of Engineering and spent 3days (27th, 28th and 29th October 2023) to verify all the documents for authenticity of the data provided in SAR and also visited all the central facilities in campus-II. The Exit meeting was held on 29th October 2023 in which Chancellor, Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Assistant Managing Trustee, Finance Officer, PRO, Coordinator-Campus II, Dean, Engineering and HoD-CSE attended.

The Chairman of the Peer team Prof. Chittaranjan Mandal and Prof. Vishal Bhatnagar one of the evaluator briefed about the strengths of School of Engineering and areas to be concentrated for further development. The overall impression of the Peer team members about the institution was very good and we are confident of getting 3 years of Accreditation for B.E.-CSE program.
