Board of Studies meeting held on 24.03.2018 at 10.30 am. Room No.: 65

The Board of Studies members discussed the agenda for the meeting. The outcomes of the discussion were as follows:

In regards to the shifting of the concept from Faculty to School, the Department of Psychology has been listed under the 'School of Arts and Social Sciences'.

The board reviewed the Scheme of Instruction, Examination and Syllabi of the Undergraduate programme in Psychology applicable for the students admitted from academic year 2018-2019 onwards was discussed and:

- 1. The paper on 'Introduction to Theories and Systems of Psychology' has been replaced to 'Physiological Psychology' in the I Semester.
- 2. Text books and Reference books have been updated.
- 3. The advancement of 'Developmental Psychology' as a paper to the II Semester was found suitable.
- Change of title of the papers 'Psychopathology' and 'Advanced Psychopathology' to 'Abnormal Psychology I and II' respectively was approved.

- 5. The syllabi of 'Computer Applications in Psychology' was deliberated upon and opined that it can also be included as a paper in Post Graduation to include operating of SPSS and its uses.
- 6. The introduction of 'Positive Psychology' was appreciated by the external as it is highly relevant to the current areas of application in Psychology.

The board reviewed the Programme Outcomes, Programme Specific Outcomes, Objectives and Course Outcomes for Post Graduate and Under Graduate programmes. The external member was appreciative for they were inclusive of the all topics covered in the syllabus and was also found to be in line with the knowledge gained by the students.

The part-IV Skill Enhancement Courses such as Co-Curricular, Value-Added Courses were also reviewed and found satisfactory.

'Ability Enhancement- Compulsory Course' on 'Environmental Studies' has been approved to be offered in the II Semester of Undergraduation.

As per the UGC guidelines, 'Swachcha Bharat-Swastha Bharat Scheme' will be implemented as an elective course for Undergraduation.

The list of subject experts for Selection Committee, Question Paper Setting, Paper Valuation and Research Committee was updated.

The external expert was very appreciative of MOOC courses for the Postgraduate Psychology students.

MOOC Courses offered for the M.Sc. Psychology students through Swayam portal is very limited with no mention of credit. If MOOC is to be offered for Undergraduate students a course in 'Introduction to Psychology 'will help in getting an overview of the subject.

Based on request from students of Psychology, the number of Continuous Internal Examinations to be conducted was discussed in the board and the suggestion to have best two out of three tests can be considered to avoid the conduction of re-tests and that caution should be taken in the equal distribution of syllabus between the three tests.
