SARADALAYA TAILORING UNIT



Saradalaya tailoring unit was started in the year 1979 and funded by the Central Social Welfare Board. This was instituted exclusively for Women's self-help group. Five women are employed in the unit. The Tailoring Unit is monitored by the department of Textiles and

fashion apparel of the university. The working numbers of Saradalaya Tailoring unit are well skilled in designing and stitching different types of ladies and children garments.

The unit undertakers all types of garments like saree blouse saree, petticoat, salwar kameez. Middy top, frock, nightie, fancy frock, designer wear blouse and garments for cultural programme. Apart from this, they also stitch school uniform for high school and middle school girls. This year school uniforms were stitched. Lab coats were stitched for engineering students. Special folders were made and supplied to Ph.D candidates. In addition to this, patch work, pickotassleing, hemming, falls fixing and many other works were carried out as per requirement of customers. Tailoring unit works throughout the year. It helps the hostel students as it is inside the campus within the guidance of textile and clothing department staff members and head of the department. The members in the tailoring unit are enhancing their stitching skill and their excellence is shown in finished products. On an average the employed women earn about Rs.6000-8000 per month.

Amirtham is a low cost nutritious food for all age groups in all conditions pregnant to lactating and ailing to convalescing. This food mixture contains balanced quantities of Wheat, rosted Bengal gram, Soya, Groundnut and Jiggery. One hundred grams of the food mixture Amirtham provides one third of the daily requirements energy and protein to the child. The sale is being carried out through college students, school children, awareness training campaign, participation in exhibitions; development of audio visual aids such as leaf lets pamphlets etc.

Media Centre



The Video Production Studio in Avinashilingam Institute for Home Science and Higher Education for Women was started in the year 2019 under UGC Non Plan account. The studio spans around 1300 sq. ft including acoustically treated shooting floor for 1,000 sq. ft space ideal for quality video production. It is equipped with high end equipment for shooting and editing videos, sound

recording and editing. The professional studio lights mounted over rails can be moved in required positions and this enable the necessary lighting setting for taking videos. The Video Production Studio was established with the prime purpose of creating educational videos by the faculty members, external agencies and other institutions. In addition to fulfilling the in-house requirements, the studio is available for commercial purposes of the external agencies as a shooting floor or as the facility to create both educational and commercial videos. The video production studio is used for coverage of institutional events and celebrations too. The students of Visual Communication programme also use this studio for learning multi camera production.
