A Two Day Academic Manuscript Preparation Workshop

A Two Day Academic Workshop on Manuscript Preparation was jointly organised by School of Biosciences and R& D cell at Bioscience seminar hall on 26.10.2023 and 27.10.2023. Nearly 35 research scholars of School of Biosciences participated in the workshop. The workshop was organised with an objective to discuss the abilities of writing a scientific manuscript and report, along with its components. By following the scientific writing guidelines, participants will become proficient to explain the overall strengths and limits of the study and will acquire the skills to write good manuscripts.

Day 1 of the workshop started with the prayer song followed by the welcome address by Dr. Nirmala Devi, Assistant Professor, Biochemistry, Biotechnology and Bioinformatics. She also introduced the Chief Guest of the day Dr. Biswaranjan Paital, Redox Regulation Laboratory, Department of Zoology, Odisha University of Agriculture and Technology. The workshop was presided over by the Deputy Dean, School of Bioscience Dr. K S Santhy. In her talk she highlighted on the qualities a researcher should possess. She motivated the participants by explaining her experience in the research, recalling the stories of great Scientists, Madam Curie and Albert Einstein who was a great inspiration to her. She emphasised that above all qualities curiosity and observation are very essential for a researcher as it can look things into various perspectives and contribute to a better research. She concluded her words signifying that the outcome of a good quality research lies in the ability of the researcher to communicate the findings clearly and effectively. After the presidential address, The Research Director I/c, Dr.P Lalitha greeted the participants. The session was followed by an introductory speech by the Chief Guest where he outlined the contents to be covered during the workshop.

After the inauguration, the session was taken over by Dr. Biswaranjan Paital which served as a opportunity for the scholars to enhance their writing skills. He covered the topics on

- Research and Education
- Need of Research in education
- Fate of Research, a phronetic approach
- How to write and get published
- How to choose a publisher or journal
- False journals
- Online Tools

He also explained briefly on the Structure of manuscript, Keys for publication in reputed platforms, How to choose a journal and Online tools to find journal. From his presentation the students were able to gain knowledge on the techniques to improve the report writing, compiling report, data interpretation and presentation.

After his presentation an interactive session was held where the participants raised their queries on the problems they faced while selecting a journal, rejection of the articles by the journals and uploading of the manuscript. The speaker elucidated with his expertise and encouraged the participants to explore the areas of interest. He concluded his session highlighting the significance of collaborations and also insisted that the development of products is not the end of the research but it should create an impact on the society. The vote of thanks for the session was given by Dr. K S Santhy, Deputy Dean, School of Bioscience.

The Day 2 started with a talk by Dr. K S Santhy, Deputy Dean, School of Bioscience on the importance of the statistics in research. She provided the basic knowledge on the statistics used in research such as ANOVA, Students t Test, Chi Square test and explained the ways to interpret the data. The students were highly benefited with the information. The session was followed by Dr. M Poonkotai, Associate Professor, Department of Zoology where she discussed on her own experience in resolving the comments given by the editor and reviewer on submitting the manuscript. The outcome of the session created a mindset among the students to accept the critics about their manuscript in a positive way. Next session was given by Dr. Nirmala Devi, Assistant Professor, Biochemistry, Biotechnology and Bioinformatics. She discussed on the Novelty, Research gap, hypothesis, target people, Product development, Cost effectiveness, References and the Societal problems which should be the essential elements to prepare a Good Quality journal.

In the valedictory meeting of the workshop, Dr. Lalitha, Director I/c, R & D assessed on the outcome of the workshop. All positive feedback about the workshop was given by the participants. The workshop was relevant to the title and was well appreciated by the students. The workshop was concluded by Vote of Thanks given by Dr. K S Santhy, Deputy Dean, School of Bioscience.
