Further the special lecture shed light on the prevalence of cloned or predatory journals in the academic publishing. She detailed strategies for identifying and discerning genuine journals from predatory ones, empowering researchers to make informed decisions when selecting publication avenues.



Drawing from practical examples, she illustrated the journey of research scholars who successfully navigated the intricacies of journal selection and publication in high-impact journals. These provided researches with real-world insights into the challenges and triumphs associated with research dissemination.

Finally, she addressed the importance of safeguarding intellectual property rights through patents and copyrights. She underscored the need for researchers to proactively protect their innovations and creative works, thereby fostering innovation and knowledge dissemination while ensuring due recognition and protection.
