The programme began with a prayer song followed by introduction of the speaker by Ms.C.Akhila, Research Scholar in Chemistry.

The meeting commenced with an introduction to the organization's offices and training centers located in various cities in India, including Kolkata, New Delhi, Mumbai, and Chennai. He highlighted the availability of resources on the official website and encouraged participants to explore them to gain insights into intellectual property rights (IPR). The organization's social media platforms were also mentioned as sources of updates on programs and events. The main topic of the meeting was "Intellectual Property." The presenter, Bharat Suryawanshi, shared a visual presentation symbolizing the birth of an idea in the mind. He defined intellectual property as the product of human creativity and thinking. He emphasized that any idea originating from the human mind qualifies as intellectual property. For instance, a new novel is protected by copyright, new designs for products fall under intellectual property, and even innovative solutions for technical problems, such as herbal medicine for cancer, are considered intellectual property.

He highlighted the significance of human creativity and problemsolving abilities in generating intellectual property. Examples included innovative solutions for diseases, alternative energy sources like solar panels, and advancements in transportation such as electric vehicles. He explained that intellectual property encompasses intangible assets, in contrast to tangible possessions like cars or land.



Two primary categories of intellectual property were discussed: industrial property and copyright. Industrial property encompasses patents, designs, trademarks, and geographical indications (GI). Patents protect inventions, designs safeguard the visual appearance of products, trademarks distinguish brands, and geographical indications indicate the origin of products. Copyright, on the other hand, safeguards original literary, artistic, and creative works.

The meeting continued with the speaker providing additional insights into the process of granting patents and copyrights. He outlined the step-by-step procedures for obtaining patents and copyrights and addressed various queries from participants.

He described the process of patent examination and approval, starting with the filing of patent applications. He explained that after filing, applications undergo a screening process and are classified based on subject matter.

He concluded the session by encouraging participants to explore the different types of intellectual property, such as patents, copyrights, trade secrets, and designs. He emphasized the importance of utilizing the intellectual property system to protect and share innovations for the betterment of society.

Takes away from the Session:

- Ideas, inventions, designs, and creative works are all forms of intellectual property.
- Patents and copyrights have distinct application and examination procedures.
- Copyrights are granted for original and new works.


