Overall Satisfaction of Students about Teacher's Competency




Fig-1: Overall satisfaction of students regarding the competency of teachers




Fig:2 Overall satisfaction of students regarding the Equitable Assessment




Fig:3 Overall Satisfaction of students regarding the opportunities for skill Enhancement and Growth




Figure 4 : Overall satisfaction of students regarding the Infrastructure Facilities




Fig:5 Overall representation of satisfaction of students regarding the integration of information and communication technology tools used




Fig:7 Overall Satisfaction of Students regarding the quality of teaching-learning process
